



ADULT & CHILD SWIMMING LESSONS



STAGE 1 (Age 6-11 months)

In this course we will provide advice on how to support your baby in the water, build confidence and remove any water fears and worries. We use toys to encourage the babies to interact with the water and make a splash!

STAGE 2 (Age 1 year)

In this course we will provide advice on how to develop underwater confidence, introduce basic swimming skills like blowing bubbles and kicking, and making swimming fun!

STAGE 3 (Age 2 years)

At this stage we will provide you with advice on how to support your child swimming with flotation aids, play underwater and have fun in the pool with songs and games!

STAGE 4 (Age 3 years)

At this stage we will provide you with advice on how to begin developing basic stroke skills, give your child confidence when jumping into the pool, and encourage them to explore the pool environment safely!
