He retired from the ministry on 31 March 1970. His 2nd marriage was to Marion Stewart Morgan (Mora)(d.30 Nov 1991) on 28 April 1970. He died at 1 Breadalbane Crescent, Wick on 23rd October 1984, aged 81, and was buried in Bower cemetery. His papers were gifted to the North Highland Archive by his brother-in-law, Robert K. Morgan. (Mr. Morgan was also a lay preacher and some of the collection may be attributable to him though it is difficult to say specifically which, as much of the work is undated.)
