> Robert Walker moved to Caithness as a child when his father was posted to Dounreay in 1959. His family spent a year in Strathy before

being relocated to Thurso into 'Atomic' Housing, Robert taught Science/Biology at Thurso High School for all of his working life

and was an avid bird watcher and

photographer.

Sandy Gunn

Sandy Gunn worked at Vulcan and was also a keen photographer along with Robert, and the two of them would accompany each other to take photographs of the area and their personal

interests.

Iain Sutherland

lain Sutherland was a prolific local historian who was born in Wick and who lived in Wick all of his life. Jain was awarded an MBE for his services to local heritage in 2006. He was an employee at the Dounreay Nuclear Site for many years before retiring and becoming the Chairman of the Wick Society where he was fundamental in securing premises for the Wick Heritage Museum and preserving local

heritage. Iain sadly passed away in 2020, aged

83.

## Alexander Bain

Alexander Bain is one of the best-known Caithness inventors. He was born in Watten in 1810 and first apprenticed with a watch and clockmaker in Wick. During his apprenticeship he attended a lecture on electricity held in Thurso, and the subject fascinated him.

In 1837 Bain travelled to London to finish his apprenticeship and then in 1844 he moved back to Edinburgh to set up his workshop. During his lifetime he invented and patented a great many inventions including the electric clock, electric printing telegraph, earth battery, typewriter ribbon, the facsimile machine, insulation for electric cables and the optical measure for spirits, still in use today.
