Name of creators:	Dom Mulraine, Norman Glass, George Doull, Northern Studios, Johnston photographers, John o' Groat Journal
Administrative history:	Organised football came to Caithness in 1887, a year before the foundation of Glasgow Celtic and six years before goal nets were adopted in Scotland.
	One of the pioneers of the game in the north was a tailor of Erin Isle origin, Dominick Mulraine. His son Bill and his grandson Dominic would go on to faithfully serve Wick Groats in several roles throughout their careers.
	Young Dom, a painter decorator to trade, kept goals for Wick Groats in the 1950/60's. He was a lifelong supporter of Motherwell FC.
	He later took charge of operations at Wick Cemetery and also looked after the adjacent Harmsworth Park. With this job he had a house adjacent to the changerooms overlooking the park. Here he lived with his wife Margaret and family, Anne, and Brian.
	In this changeroom complex Dom had a small office whose walls were covered with football photos and articles he had inherited/collected over the years. The collection was much admired by visitors and often mentioned when older players met in the local pub for a beer.
	Over the years these memorials were lost from view and forgotten about.

However, local football heritage has recently seen a resurgence, with Dom's collection kindly remembered. Thankfully Dom's daughter Anne kept the photo collection in safe keeping for many years. The family kindly agreed to donate the Dom Mulraine Collection to Caithness Archives for posterity. The photos cover several local teams over a wide time period with Wick teams well covered. Also included are a booklet covering the history of Caithness Football from 1887 to 1967 by Norman Glass and a small notebook belonging to Wick Groats Manager George Doull that covers the period 1967 to 1969. This latter document contains additional information on team selections, gate receipts, a team boat trip to Orkney and individual referee assessments. The photo collection also records visits by top Scottish teams in the 1930's who played matches against Wick Academy as part of their preseason preparations.
